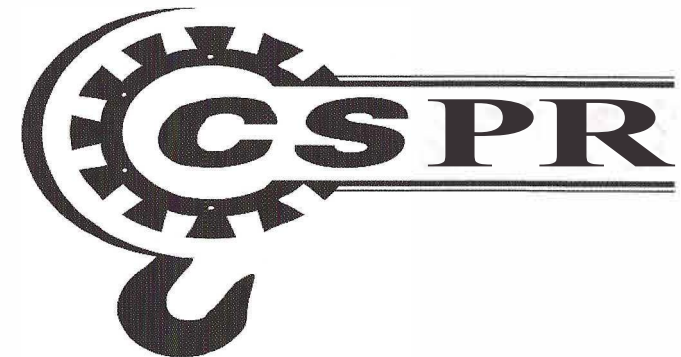

# To receive your CSPR CARD

You must do the following:

1. Complete a course in rigging and signaling of your choosing. NEIEP offers an online course, CE020 Prep, that will meet the requirement. CE20 Prep takes about 8-10 hours to complete. This is an online course. (NOTE: It is strongly recommended that individuals who complete CE020 Prep also enroll in NEIEP's 20 hour classroom course in practical rigging.
2. After completing a rigging/signaling course, visit [www.elevatorcspr.org](http://www.elevatorcspr.org) to download the Candidate Handbook and complete the online application. The application must list your current address and must be complete with electronic signatures to be processed.

3. Once the application has been reviewed and accepted by the Certification Director, you will be contacted by mail with further instructions. Remember, earning your CSPR-1 or CSPR-2 card is a lengthy process. Your certification test will consist of the following:

- A multiple choice exam, which will take about 2.5 hours to complete.
- A practical exam where you will demonstrate 21 hand signals and a variety of rigging scenarios, which will take about 2.5 hours to complete.



**UPON PASSING THE MULTIPLE CHOICE EXAMS, AND PRACTICAL EXAMS, YOU WILL BE ISSUED A TEMPORARY CARD ON-SITE.**

You will receive your permanent certification card in the mail. It will be valid for five years with regular maintenance requirements. This requirements are detailed in the Candidate Handbook, available at [www.elevatorcspr.org](http://www.elevatorcspr.org).
